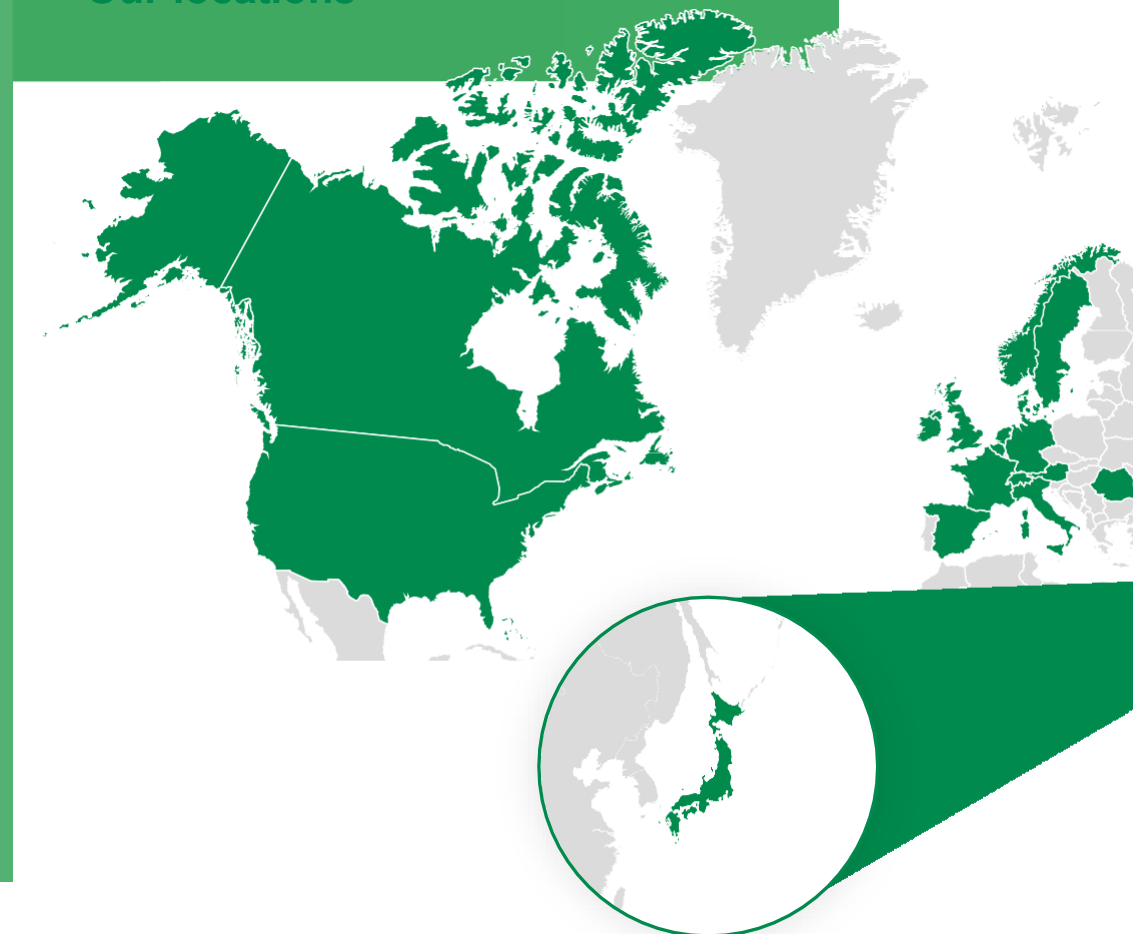

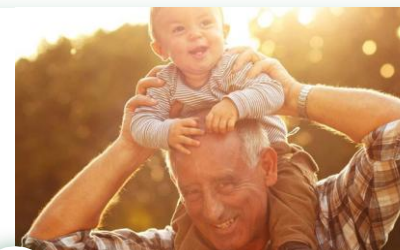
Product safety

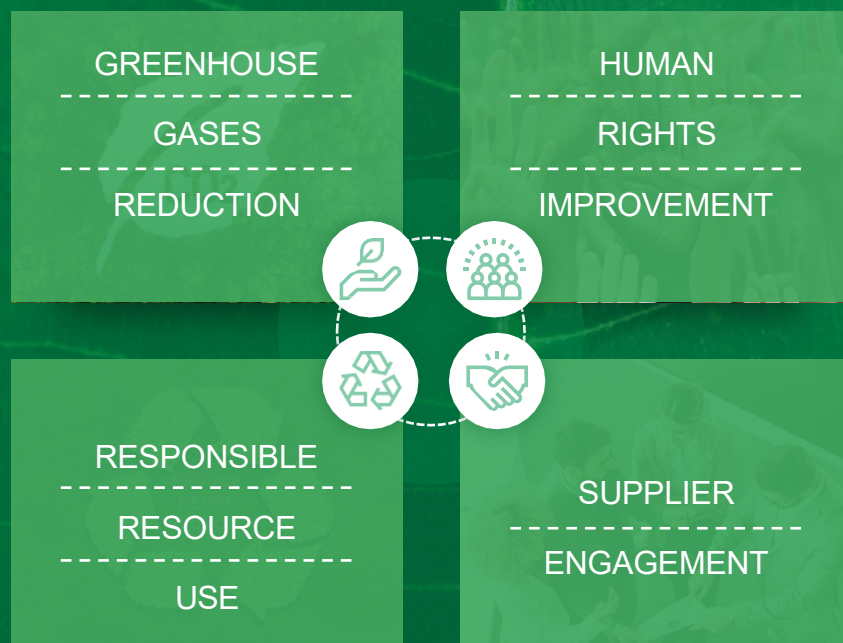

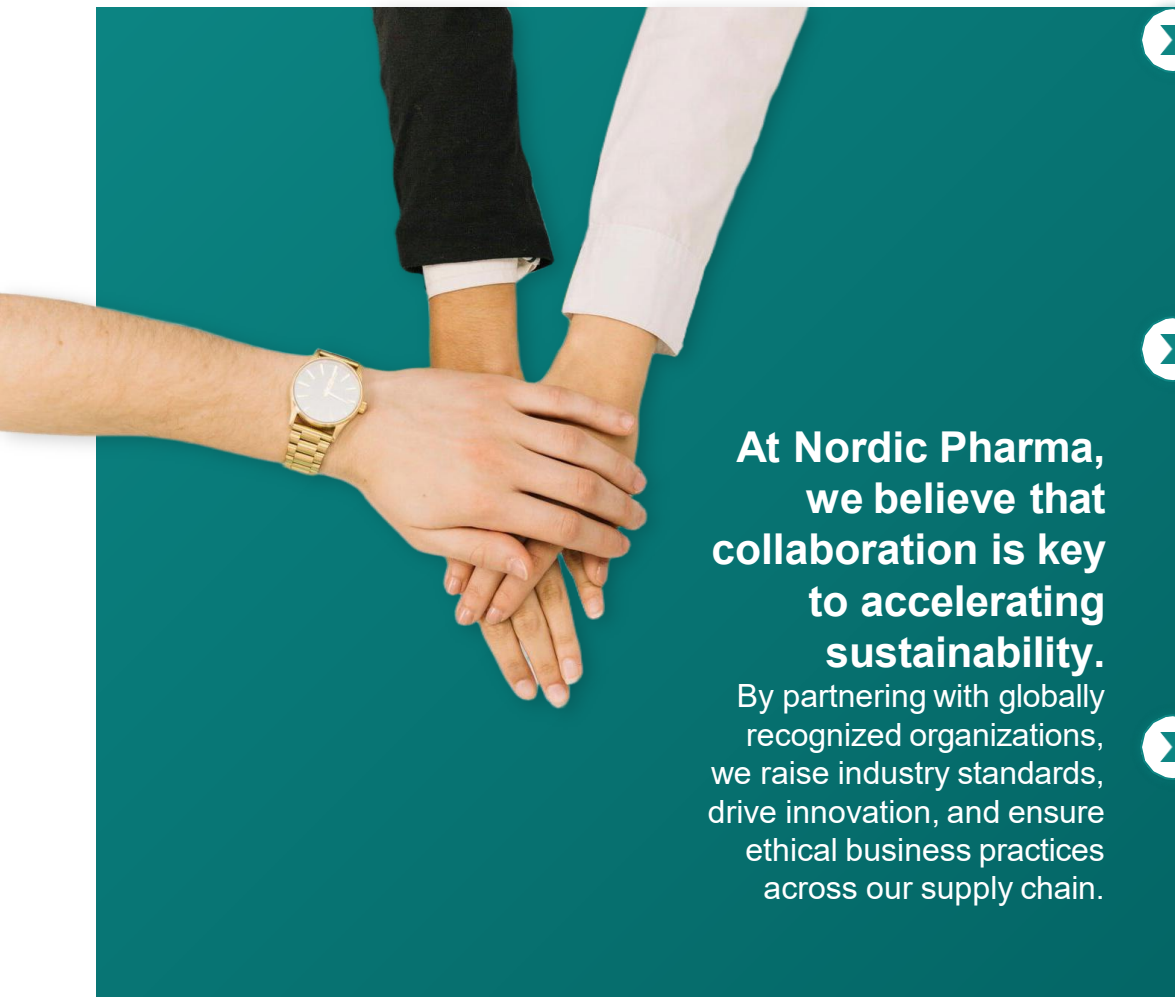

Our sustainable procurement approach and results



Supply Chain Mapping

By combining the power of strategic partnerships and global standards, Nordic Pharma is not just adapting to the evolving sustainability landscape -we are leading it. Together with our partners, we are shaping a future where progress benefits people, the planet, and the industry alike.

Our supply chain begins with the purchase of the Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient (API) from a third-party supplier.

Depending on logistical requirements, the API is transported to a Contract Manufacturing Organization (CMO) via truck or air freight. At the CMO facility, the API undergoes the manufacturing process to produce the final pharmaceutical product. Once the product is completed, it is carefully packaged and either delivered directly to our local warehouses or sent to our affiliates. From there, the final product is distributed to end customers, ensuring it reaches patients and healthcare providers efficiently and in optimal condition.



Our suppliers

Nordic Pharma focuses on the development and commercialization of specialty products.

Our expertise relies on the development and sales of our own products, but also on partner products acquired at various stages of development. Hence, Nordic Pharma fully relies on its suppliers as they are the main and only source for the production and manufacturing for our pharmaceutical products.

We believe that collaboration with like-minded suppliers is not just a business necessity but a cornerstone of our success. By aligning with partners who demonstrate a strong commitment to regulatory compliance and quality assurance, we can collectively contribute to advancing global healthcare.

There are **15 suppliers** that are located **in Europe** while **3 are located in Israel, Japan and Taiwan**.



That provides quite a complex Supply Chain, although the fact that

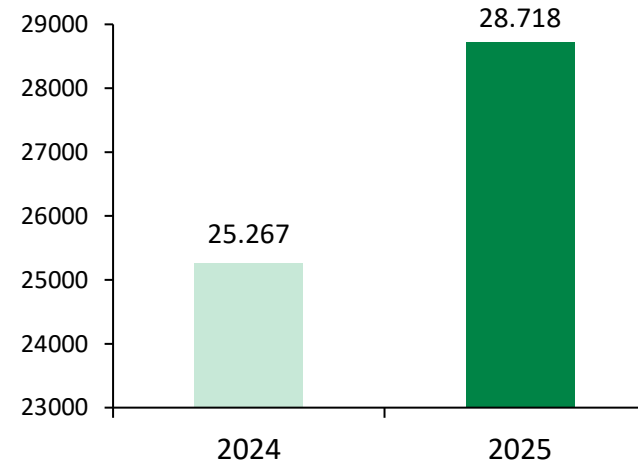

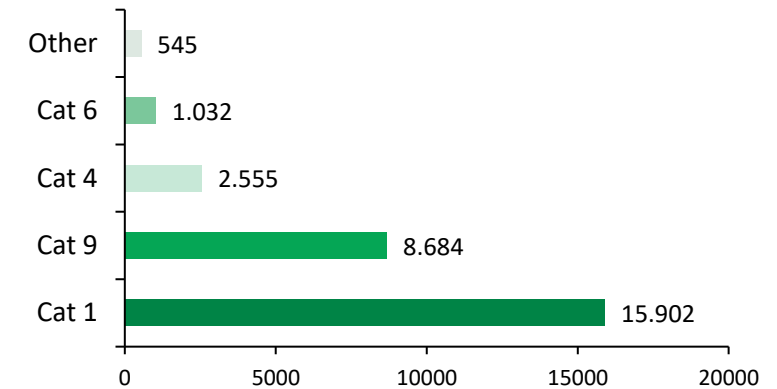

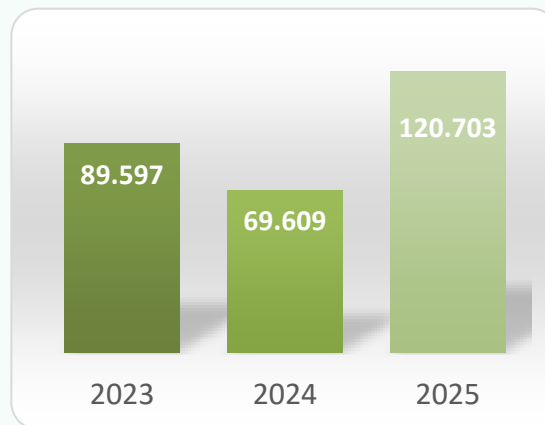
Road transport and air freight CO₂ footprint — trend and efficiency signals

Our logistics network continues to improve its environmental efficiency. In 2024, road transport emissions decreased by 22%, while air freight operations became more carbon efficient, achieving a 22% reduction in CO₂ emissions per shipment despite higher shipment volumes.

These results demonstrate the effectiveness of our transportation optimization initiatives and reinforce our commitment to reducing the environmental footprint of our supply chain while maintaining reliable service levels for patients worldwide.

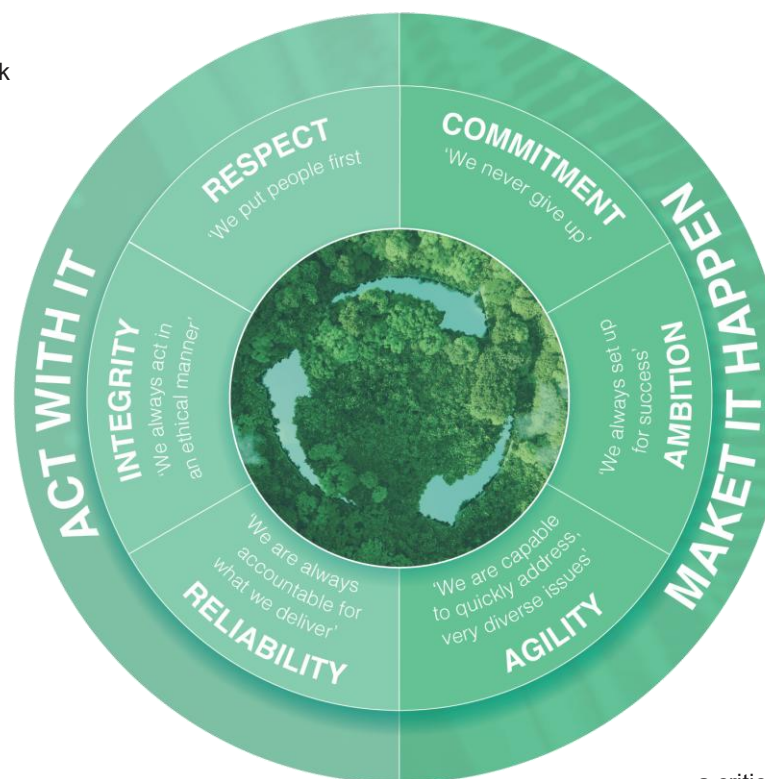

As part of our broader sustainability strategy, we have examined risks related to environmental, social, governance (ESG), and operational performance within our supply chain using the Supply Chain Vulnerability Analysis methodology. The analysis highlights potential vulnerabilities and opportunities for improvement, ensuring alignment with our sustainability objectives and corporate values. Results of the Supply Chain Risk Analysis are discussed with suppliers during the SRM meetings.

Supplier Compliance

At Nordic Pharma, we are committed

to ensuring that our suppliers meet the highest standards of environmental, social, and governance (ESG) compliance. As part of our sustainable procurement practices, we monitor and report on the compliance standards we require from our suppliers and outline the key obligations they are expected to fulfil.

Supplier Code of Conduct (CoC)

Nordic Pharma requires all suppliers to adhere to our Supplier Code of Conduct (CoC), which sets out clear expectations regarding ethical business practices, human rights, labor conditions, environmental management, and anti-corruption measures.

Supplier Contracts with ESG Clauses

To ensure accountability and measurable compliance, Nordic Pharma has integrated ESG-specific clauses into our supplier agreements. These clauses outline suppliers' responsibilities regarding environmental impact, ethical labor practices, governance standards, and reporting requirements. The below clauses have been included in our agreement template for direct suppliers.

ESG Data Access and Reporting

1 Provision of ESG Data

The Supplier agrees to provide Nordic Pharma with accurate, complete, and timely information related to the Supplier's environment impact, including but not limited to data on greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions (Scopes 1, 2, and 3), carbon footprint, water usage, energy consumption, waste management, and other relevant sustainability metrics ("ESG Data").

2 Right to Access ESG Data

Nordic Pharma reserves the right to access, review, and utilize all ESG Data provided by the Supplier for the purposes related to compliance with applicable regulations, sustainability reporting, supply chain management, and performance monitoring. The Suppliers shall cooperate with Nordic Pharma in providing such data and any necessary documentation to verify the accuracy and completeness of the information.

3 Annual ESG Reporting

The Supplier shall submit an annual ESG report to Nordic Pharma, including detailed metrics on GHG emissions (Scope 1, 2, and 3), carbon footprint, water usage, and other key environmental performance indicators as agreed upon by both parties. This report shall be provided no later than 1st of May 2025, or as otherwise mutually agreed.

4 Monitoring and Audits

Nordic Pharma may, at its discretion, conduct periodic audits, assessments, or reviews of the Supplier's environmental performance, including the verification of ESG Data provided it has informed Supplier fifteen (15) days in advance. The Supplier shall fully cooperate with any such audit and provide necessary access to facilities, records, and personnel as required. For 2026 we have already scheduled 2 ESG audits.

5 Confidentiality

The Supplier's ESG Data shall be treated as confidential information by Nordic Pharma and shall only be used for the purposes outlined in this Agreement, unless otherwise required by law or regulatory authorities. However, Nordic Pharma may disclose aggregated or anonymized ESG Data for public reporting, sustainability assessments, or other appropriate uses without breaching confidentiality.

Supplier Compliance

Compliance with Specific ESG Regulations

Nordic Pharma ensures that suppliers comply with both global and regional ESG regulations, reflecting our commitment to sustainability and ethical business practices. Suppliers are required to adhere to the EU Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD), where applicable, and comply with industry-specific regulations, such as Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP). This approach not only mitigates supply chain risks but also reinforces our vision for a sustainable and ethical procurement process.

Supplier Selection and Assessment

Supplier selection and evaluation

are key aspects of our sustainability strategy. We carefully assess potential suppliers based on their environmental, ethical, and social practices, favoring those who share our commitment to responsible operations. By choosing suppliers who align with our values, we create a network of partners who contribute to our sustainability goals.

Our use of SRM tools allows us to track suppliers' performance on sustainability metrics, ensuring that they maintain compliance with our standards. Regular evaluations and transparent communication help us foster a culture of continuous improvement, where each supplier is encouraged to enhance their sustainability efforts over time.

Supplier Selection Process (to be implemented in 2026)

The supplier selection process at Nordic Pharma is designed to ensure that all new partners meet our operational, quality, and sustainability standards from the outset.

Pre-Qualification Screening. New suppliers undergo an initial evaluation based on core business criteria, including operational capabilities, quality systems, financial stability, and adherence to Nordic Pharma's Supplier Code of Conduct (CoC).

ESG criteria assessment

Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) factors are integrated into supplier evaluations, focusing on:



Environmental:

- **Third-Party Assessments – EcoVadis:**
We expect our suppliers to be assessed by EcoVadis — a recognized sustainability rating.' In this assessment, suppliers are evaluated based on their ESG performance
- **PSCI audits and On-Site Assessments:**
Strategic suppliers undergo regular on-site audits to validate their ESG compliance and identify areas for improvement. Audits include reviews of documentation, production processes, and working conditions.
- **Performance Monitoring and Feedback:**
Strategic supplier performance is monitored through key performance indicators (KPIs), including carbon emissions, labor standards compliance, and waste reduction initiatives.



Nordic Pharma collaborates with suppliers to **address gaps and implement corrective action plans where necessary.**

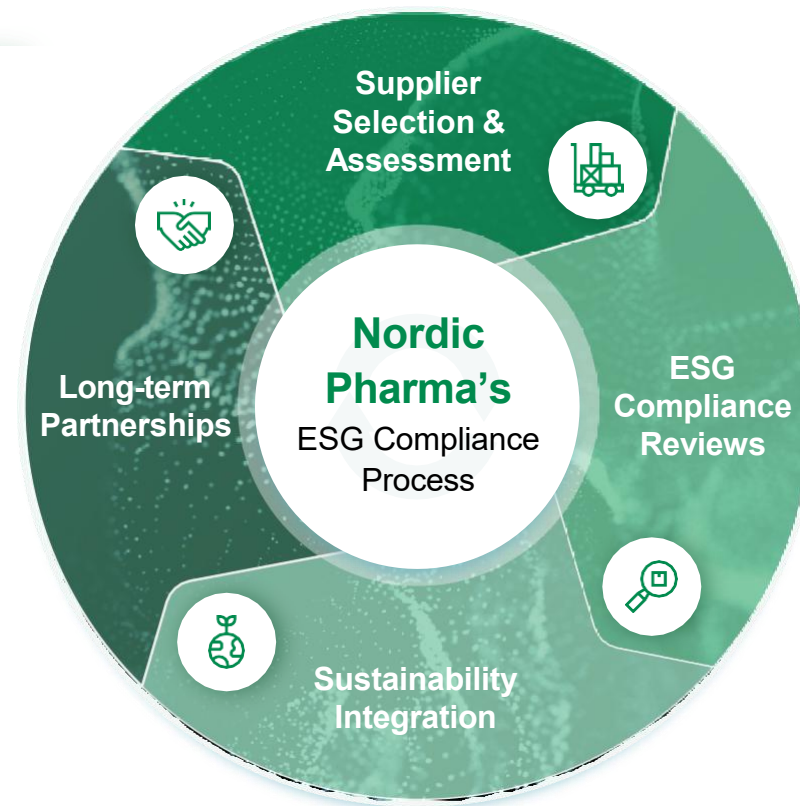
Supplier Engagement

Quality: Product consistency, production processes, and quality control systems.



Governance: Ethical business practices, anti-corruption policies, and documentation transparency.

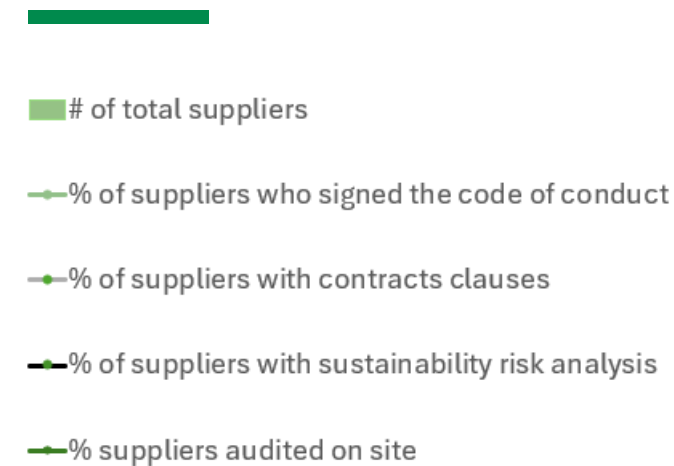
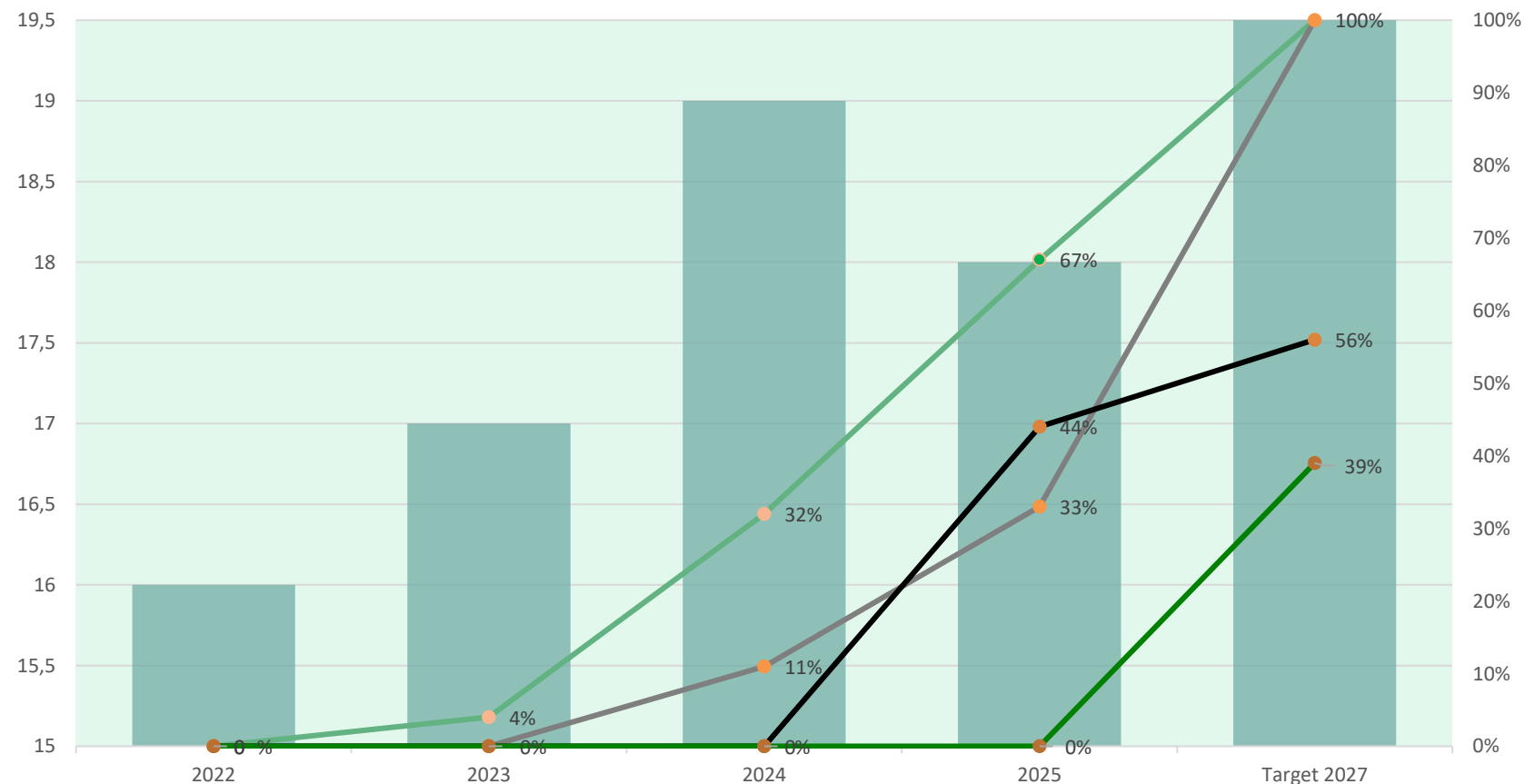
